

At a Legal Meeting of the Inhabitants of the Northerly Parish in the town of Kittery Regular Assembled, Jan'y 15th, 1810, and Past the following votes, viz.—

Andrew P. Fernald, Esq'r, Chosen Moderator to Govern said Meeting.

voted to Choose Agents to Send to the General Court of this Commonwealth.

Voted that ANDREW P. FERNALD, Esq'r and Capt. ELISHA SHAPLEIGH be Agents with full Power in the Name and behalf of the Second Parish in the town of Kittery, to attend the General Court to be holden in Boston on the third Wednesday in Jan'y Inst. and there to use their utmost Endeavors to carry into effect the Petetion of Andrew P. Fernald, Esq'r an Agent in behalf of said Parish to said Court in June last, or to Petition Said Court anew that said Parish be Incorporated into a town, that when Incorporated may Injoy the Previleges of the Incorporated towns of this Commonwealth.

voted that the Inhabitants of this Parish Return their thanks to their Agent,—ANDREW P. FERNALD, Esq'r,— for his Exertion at the General Court in June last, in petitioning for and obtaining an Order of notice for this Parish to be set off into a Separate town.

And that we Injoin it upon him with his Colleague to persevere and use all fair and honorable means to carry said petetion into effect, or to petition anew as they may think proper.
